Before Assembly:

- Take the entire kit out of the box and review all of the sprues to familiarize yourself with the different parts.
 - Note: take care when removing the contents of the box, sometime small parts will fall off of the sprues and be loose in the box.
- Read and understand all of the instructions.
- Decide what colors you want to paint your structure. Such as I want the bricks to be Foquel Rust, windows to be Model Master SAC bomber green, Roof Foquel Black and such.
 - NEVER just assemble the building without painting it even if the plastic is the colors that you want. You will have a much more eye pleasing structure if you paint it first.

Kit Assembly:

- Begin by assembling parts that will be painted the same color.
- Carefully remove parts from the sprues by using the Tweezer Sprue Cutters
- Now file each piece to remove any excess plastic that remains from where the part was attached to the sprue.
 - Note: always start with a fine file and if needed use the coarser files. Remember once the plastic is removed you can't put it back on!
- If you are working on wall pieces, i.e. DPM kit, you need to sand/file the sides to make sure you get a completely "square" wall. Also be careful you don't sand a side of the wall that has details on it (brick outline)
- Once your pieces are filed, you are ready to assemble them. Glue pieces that will be painted the same color together using Tenax 7R or Faller Expert Cement. Sometimes you will need to give it some time to dry before adding more pieces to the same element. Such as putting together a DPM kit. You glue only two walls together at a time.
- Once you have painted all of your "same color parts" you can finish completing the kit.
 - Note: Do NOT put the windows in at this time.
- Once you have your structure completely assembled, spray your building with a dull coat or clear flat coat paint.
- After the Clear Coat is dry, you can begin to installing the windows to your kit. However, if you want frosted windows, just spray the inside of the kit with the dull coat to give your windows this "frosted" look.

Now you have a completed kit/industry to help complete the scenery on your layout!

Notes:
